


Biblical History: Israel's Kingdom Period

Key to Understanding Historical Map

Good King
Evil King

When a king is referred to in scripture by more than one name, the alternate name is in parenthesis; ex. Azariah (Uzziah)

The Northern Kingdom (Israel) is pictured on top, while the Southern Kingdom (Judah) is on the bottom. Years are based on the beginning of Saul's rule.



- 1 David rules 7½ years over Judah, 33 over whole Israel.
